## Notice to Stakeholders - Blood Regulations come into force

Health Canada is pleased to announce that the *Blood Regulations* and consequential amendments under the authority of the *Food and Drugs Act*, published in *Canada Gazette*, Part II (<u>http://www.gazette.gc.ca/gazette/home-accueil-eng.php</u>) come into force **October 23, 2014**.

The *Blood Regulations* contain safety requirements with respect to blood for transfusion or for further manufacture and apply to all establishments who handle blood.

The final *Guidance Document: Blood Regulations* is effective on October 23, 2014. Please find attached the Guidance Document which interprets the *Blood Regulations* for all establishments who perform any of the regulated activities. The *Establishment Licence Application Form* and *Registration Application Form* are also attached. - The Inspection Strategy for Blood Establishments (POL-0039) (<u>http://www.hc-</u> <u>sc.gc.ca/dhp-mps/compli-conform/info-prod/don/pol-0039\_eng.php</u>) document is intended to provide information on Health Canada's approach to inspections of all blood establishments regulated under the *Blood Regulations*.
- The guidance document entitled: *Risk Classification of Observations made during Inspections of Blood Establishments (GUI-0061)(<u>http://www.hc-sc.gc.ca/dhp-</u> <u>mps/compli-conform/info-prod/don/gui-0061-eng.php</u>) is an administrative tool to inform blood establishments on how observations noted during inspections regulated under the <i>Blood Regulations* are classified by Health Canada.
- Blood Regulations Error or Accident Investigation Preliminary Report Form (FRM-0337) (<u>http://www.hc-sc.gc.ca/dhp-mps/compli-conform/info-prod/don/frm-0337\_eng.php</u>) is intended to facilitate the submission of error and accident reports that are required to be submitted to Health Canada within 24 hours, as per section 107 of the Blood Regulations.
